Historical Note

The Watertown Woman's Club was founded by Alice M. Potter Silsbee in 1894 "to stimulate literary effort, and promote the social life of the members." Silsbee and other club founders invited members from all church denominations, though the club size was restricted to 150 women. The Club held regular literary exercises, organized classes in the fine and domestic arts and current events, and hosted lectures by subject experts. Members also established a choral group and gave an annual reception or musical entertainment. By the early 1900s, club activities expanded to include community service and fundraising.

- 1946 - Sold Club House
- 1951 - Established Civil Defense Committee
- 1960s - Established Mary Lulu Cleveland Scholarship Fund
- 1980s - Collected food for women's shelter, donated to veterans' home

Organization and Arrangement

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains Watertown Woman's Club organizational and administrative records including meeting minutes, yearbooks, scrapbooks, internal committee records and officers' reports, and special program and event files.

Series I consists of Watertown's Woman's Club meeting minutes, Executive Board meeting minutes, and Trustees meeting minutes. Some books include both Executive Board and Regular meeting minutes, and other books only contain one or the other.

Series II consists of Watertown Woman's Club scrapbooks. Scrapbooks contain a variety of material, including photographs of club members, newspaper articles about the club, and notes and programs from the Massachusetts State Federation of Women's Clubs.

Series III consists of Watertown Woman's Club yearbooks. Each yearbook includes a list of officers, calendar, standing committee members, and a member directory. Additional yearbooks (not listed in this inventory) may be found taped into the scrapbooks of Series II.

Series IV contains organizational records—including annual and monthly reports by club officers, special committee reports, official ballots, club statements and resolutions—presumably previously in the keeping of club presidents. Some files also include correspondence, clippings, and Massachusetts State Federation of Women’s Club records. Folders are arranged chronologically, by presidential terms.

Series V contains special program records, committee records, press clippings and early organizational records. It includes internal committee records, include records of the Committee on the Club Seal, the Garden Club, the Trustees Club House Ways and Means Committee, and the Committee for Remodeling of Club Property and Club Property Committee. This series also contains Watertown Woman’s Club grant and national contest applications, citations of achievement from state and national foundations, scholarship recipient files (1983 to 1990), and programs and pamphlets for special events including the Historic Watertown Community Pageant (1919), the Northeastern Massachusetts Music Festival (1956), Philanthropy Day (1953), Valentine card Party and Fashion Show (1955), and various 60th and 100th club anniversary events. Other records include early club membership lists (1903 to 1924) and annotated waiting lists (1909 to 1914). A bound volume labeled *Watertown Woman’s Club Press Notices, 1931-32, 1932-33*, contains local newspaper articles about the club compiled by Minnie H. Gulesian, Club Press Correspondent, as well as instructions regarding press releases and some club programs. All items are dated and labeled.
